**PROCEDURE AND DIRECTIVES FOR SMOOTH FUNCTIONING ON ANTI-RAGGING,  
GGDC, DANTAN-II**

➤ **Vision & Mission**

‘Ragging’ is a harsh reality in the higher education system of our country. This term is defined as any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student. This can lead to adverse effects such as depression, anxiety & sometimes even suicide. This malpractice is not desirable for our society as well as country. In accordance with Supreme Court judgments & directions, UGC guideline & State Government instructions, our Government General Degree College, Dantan-II is following ‘Zero Tolerance policy’ towards ragging. The college has formed an Anti-Ragging cell, committee and squad to build a ragging free ambience in the campus.

**ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE (ARC), GGDC DANTAN-II**

With effect from September 2020, a new composition of Anti-Ragging Cell/ Committee has been introduced in our Government General Degree College, Dantan-II. The Anti-Ragging Committee is reconstituted every year in our college. The Committee includes members (Associate/Assistant Professors) representing all the Faculties with the Officer-in-Charge as the Chairperson. The committee needs often and when needed to discuss directives received from UGC and put them in to action. As per **UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009, clause no. 6.4 Setting up of Committees and their functions**, our college has formed the Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad according to the below mentioned structure –

1. The head of the Institution shall be the Chairman of the ARC.
2. Officer-in-Charge of the nearby Police station.
3. One Health Officer/ Civil Administrator.
4. One coordinator of ARC, from the faculty, to be nominated by the Principal.
5. Four senior faculty members to be nominated by the Principal.
6. One representative from the Parent.
7. One representative from the NGO.
8. One media person.
9. One UG student representative.
10. One member from non-teaching employee.

➤ **Objectives of Anti-Ragging committee:**

- To make the students aware of the dehumanizing effects of ragging.
- To keep a continuous vigil so as to prevent the occurrence and recurrence of ragging.
- To generate an atmosphere of discipline.
- To address any ragging issues immediately and take action as advised by the concerned Committee.
- To act on the defaulters who are found guilty of ragging and /or abetting ragging, actively or passively, or being part of a conspiracy to promote ragging.

**ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD (ARS), GGDC DANTAN-II**

As per UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009, clause no. 6.4 Setting up of Committees and their functions the Anti-ragging Squad should be a body with vigil, oversight and patrolling functions and should appropriately be a smaller body which should be nominated by the head of the institution with such representation as considered necessary and shall consist of members belonging to the various section of the campus community. The constitution of Anti-Ragging Squad of our college is:

➤ **Functions of Anti-Ragging Squad:**

- Identify and inspect places of potential ragging
- Make surprise visits in class room and college premises
- Ensure stakeholder participation in the effort
- Be vigilant for unanticipated events

➤ **Prohibitive measures taken up by Anti-Ragging Committee:**

- Declaring our college as 'Ragging free campus': public declaration of intent in visual, audio-visual, electronic or print and other media.
- Adequate impetus given through hoardings/ billboards kept at vantage points and through website.
- General awareness created through orientation program for parents as well as freshers.
- Obtaining affidavits by parents and candidates during admission.
- The help line numbers of the Anti-Ragging Committee are displayed in the website of our college and at the entrance of the campus for assistance of the students.

➤ **Preventive measures taken up (before admission) as per Clause 6.1:**

- Through media: as stated earlier, has made public declaration of intent in visual, print and other media as a ragging free campus.
- Brochures for admission, handbook of the college, prospectus has printed matters on these rules and regulations.
- Handbook gives details on the Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad with contact details.
- At the time of admission both parents and candidates are requested to fill and sign an Affidavit on Anti-Ragging.
- Regular policing by Squad in the beginning of the odd semester every year.
- Installation of CCTV at vantage and vulnerable points in the campus.

➤ **Preventive measures taken up (on admission) as per Clause 6.2:**

- Prepare freshers not to oblige to such practices if at all they fresh any but to report boldly and immediately.
- Mandated Orientation Program for freshers and parents to make concern them with the rules and regulations of Anti-Ragging measures.
- Installation of a complaints box by the local police station.
- Notify the rights to freshers in case of event – Grievance Cell, Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad, RTI etc.
- Documentation of complete details of the freshers.
- Organizing Fresher's Day as a mark of welcome by senior students.
- Motivate to make friendly relationships by staff and senior students.
- Have mentioned the rules and regulations and the consequences to be faced, in the prospectus and printed handbook.

➤ **Preventive measures taken up (at the end of the academic session) as per Clause 6.3:**

- Constituted Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad and their functional.
- Core members address students and direct them in the right path.

➤ **Initiatives to prevent the menace of ragging:**

- Anti-Ragging committee members motivated the students to attend the seminars based on Anti-ragging to keep abreast of recent issues and solution.
- The telephone numbers of the Anti-Ragging helpline are displayed in the website of our college.
- Before the commencement of every academic session the Officer-in-Charge of our college convenes and addresses a meeting with the various functionaries of the college to discuss the measures to be taken to prevent ragging in the college.
- Organizing rallies within and outside the campus as an awareness generation measure.
- Conduct competitions like posters making, paintings on ragging and or Anti-Ragging to create awareness among students.

➤ **Ragging Complaint Mechanism:**

- Students may inform to the Officer-in-Charge, GGDC, DANTAN-II.
- Students may also report to the HOD/ any teacher of the college.

➤ **Punishment Provisions in the event of ragging:**

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

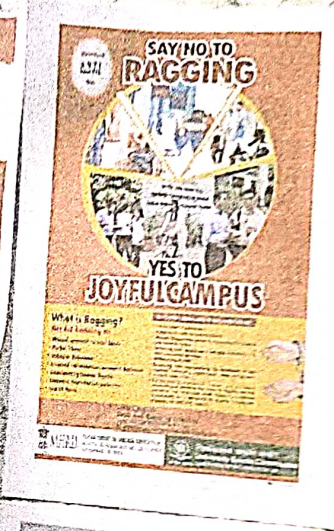
- Debarring from appearing in any semester or withholding results
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
- Suspension from the college for a period of one month
- Cancellation of admission
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Rustication from the college for periods varying from 1 to 4 semester or equivalent period
- Fine up to twenty five thousand rupees
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both
- Collective punishment – when the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggars.

Any Act Resulting in:

- Mental/physical/sexual Abuse
- Verbal Abuse
- Indecent Behaviour
- Criminal Intimidation/wrongful Restraint
- Undermining Human Dignity
- Financial Exploitation/extortion
- Use Of Force

### A STUDENT INDULGING IN RAGGING CAN BE:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding/withdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc.
- Collective punishment : when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the Institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on potential ragger.
