## POLICY DOCUMENT ON WASTE MANAGEMENT

Government General Degree College, Dantan-II has implemented a thorough waste management program. It has been determined that preserving ecological preservation and an eco-friendly atmosphere on campus requires the implementation of sustainable practices and efficient waste management. In order to reduce its carbon footprint and to provide a safe and healthy work environment for its teaching and non-teaching staff, students, visitors, and other stakeholders, the college works to implement sustainable and holistic waste management.

## **Objectives:**

• To separate waste materials into categories such as liquid, e-waste, biodegradable, and non-biodegradable.

- To improve personnel and students' comprehension of proper waste management practices.
- To collaborate with regional administrations to manage waste in an appropriate manner.
- To keep the campus environment green.

## **Policies:**

It is mandatory for all employees and students at Government General Degree College, Dantan-II, to dispose of their garbage in dustbins that are labelled appropriately based on the type of waste.

**1. Solid Waste:** The College has a collection and disposal agreement in place with the nearby "Dantan-II Gram Panchayat" for "Solid waste" produced on campus. The trash is divided into several categories and placed in clearly designated, covered bins around the campus. Green Bins are used to collect biodegradable waste, whereas Blue Bins are used to collect non-biodegradable waste. The nonbiodegradable trash kept in the covered bins are collected by the Gram Panchayat using a "Garbage Van" that is dispatched to the campus. The campus vegetable garden is used to dispose of biodegradable garbage.

2. Liquid Waste: Both lab and sanitary waste are gathered in a pit and released outdoors via a panchayat-maintained drain.

3. **E-Waste:** The college store room is used to gather and store e-waste. The appropriate disposal of this kind of garbage is currently under discussion with the higher authorities.
