POLICY DOCUMENT ON WATER CONSERVATION

Rain water at Government General Degree College, Dantan-II is gathered and sent straight into the pond via a pipe. This makes it possible to raise the water's subsurface level. Additionally, this causes groundwater to recharge. Three sources of water supply the campus: (1) Ground water; (2) Rain Water; and (3) Pond. The Pond and overhead tanks are used to store water.

Objectives:

- Preserving College Pond's pure water supply (rainwater).
- To give stakeholders, staff, and students access to filtered RO water for drinking.
- To keep the College Garden maintained by properly irrigating plants with rainwater collected.
- To prevent spills, leaks, and overflows by shutting off the faucets.
- To educate interested parties about the value of water conservation.

Policies:

The Pond and overhead tanks are used to store water. Water is used for a variety of purposes, including the following:

1. The pond receives rainwater that is routed through pipes. As a result, rainwater is collected and groundwater is replenished.
2. Borehole water is used in taps.
3. The RO filters located at the administration building provide the drinking water.
